STANDARDIZED TEST RESULTS

Candidates for the undergraduate programs must submit their scores from the SAT the areas of math and reading.

The candidate must have received a minimum score of 35.5 out of 40 in the "Math" test and a total score of 65 out of 80 in the "Math" and "Reading" tests of the SAT.
