The course list is updated approximately one month before the registration periods (August and January). Therefore, course selections made during the application process are considered provisional.</p> <p>During the official registration period, students' course lists may change depending on course quotas and the consent of instructors.</p> <p>In cases of urgent inquiries regarding course availability or status, students are advised to contact the relevant departmental coordinators or course instructors directly for further guidance.</p>
Grading	<p>The grading system at Boğaziçi University is based on letter grades. The corresponding descriptions and grade points are as follows:</p> <p>AA – Excellent (4.0) BA – Good–Excellent (3.5) BB – Good (3.0) CB – Passing–Good (2.5) CC – Passing (2.0) DC – Passing–Poor (1.5) DD – Poor (1.0) F – Fail (0.0)</p>
Credit System	<p>Boğaziçi University uses a credit-hour system. A typical course is 3 or 4 Bogazici credits (5-7 ECTS) with at least 3 contact hours per week. The ECTS credits of courses can be found in the Course Catalogue.</p>
Credits per semester for full-time student	<p>4 - 6 courses, equaling 15-24 Bogazici credits (approximately 20-30 ECTS).</p>
Minimum and maximum number of credits that can be taken by Incoming Students	<p>Erasmus and Exchange students are expected to take 4 - 6 courses, equaling 17-21 Bogazici credits (approximately 20-30 ECTS).</p>

Admissions

Boğaziçi University uses the “nomination by the home & admission by the host” system. All Erasmus/Exchange students are nominated by their home institution. Boğaziçi University, as the host institution, reviews the applications and its individual academic units decide on whether to accept the applicant.

Each Erasmus/Exchange student is registered with an academic unit. The academic unit assigns the academic advisor during the registration period.

Erasmus students are expected to select at least two courses from the academic program with which they are registered. For exchange students, it is acceptable to choose one course from the registered program.

Nomination deadline: 15 April 2026 for Fall/Full-year, 15 September 2026 for Spring

After the home university makes the nomination through the form, the nominated students will be sent a link to the online application system where they can upload their documents for application.

Application deadline: 15 May 2026 for Fall/Full-year, 15 October 2026 for Spring

Documents for Application

- Original copy of the transcript in English
- Course list: Erasmus students must take a minimum of two courses from the host department, Exchange students a minimum of one. Please note that the course list during application is provisional. The actual courses will be chosen during the course registration at the beginning of the semester.
- Statement of Purpose
- Letter of Recommendation from a faculty member (in English or Turkish)
- Language requirements for all incoming students:
Non-native speakers of English must provide proof of proficiency in the English Language by means of TOEFL, IELTS, Cambridge C1 Advanced or a letter from your home university certifying B2 or higher level of proficiency. Minimum scores required: TOEFL: 550 + TWE 4.5 for the paper-based test; 213+ TWE 4.5 for the computer-based test; 79 + TWE 24 for the Internet-based test IELTS (6.5); Cambridge English: C1

Living in Istanbul: Accommodation

On-campus Accommodation

Boğaziçi University offers on-campus dormitory facilities across its campuses; however, accommodation capacity is limited. Please note that dormitories may not always be located on the same campus where a student’s academic courses are held. Dormitory applications for the Fall 2026-2027 semester are expected to open online in September 2026. Exchange students will be eligible to apply through the same online application system. Detailed information regarding the application process and important dates will be shared directly with our nominated exchange students in due course.



Off-Campus Accommodation

Boğaziçi University campuses are located in central and well-connected areas of Istanbul. Depending on the campus, private student residences may be available within walking distance or easily accessible via public transportation, including metro lines. The University is currently compiling a list of recommended private accommodation options, which will be shared with exchange students. This will allow students to review and compare multiple housing alternatives before arriving in Türkiye for their mobility period.
