

## Course Selection Worksheet for International Students

### Yale Summer Session Courses

#### How do I select the courses that are right for me?

*International Students must select two 1 credit courses to fulfill the requirements of the F-1 Student Visa. Students are allowed to choose one online course (must meet any prerequisites, certain restrictions apply).*

1. What session am I attending?
2. What is my major?
3. What subjects am I interested in?
4. Is the class open to me (are there any prerequisites)?
  - a. A prerequisite is a course you must take before selecting the current course. This would be written in the course description.
5. Have I already taken this class? You should select a course you have never taken before.
6. Would this be a good fit for me considering my English reading/writing/speaking abilities?
7. Do I need these credits for my degree at home? Have I checked if I can transfer the credit?
8. Have I explored all the course options in all subject areas?
9. Have I made sure the two courses don't meet at the same time?
10. Am I interested in taking an online course? As long as you meet the admissions requirement, you are allowed to select one online course in the session that you are coming to Yale. These courses must be selected during the application phase. They may not be added once you arrive to Yale in the summer.
