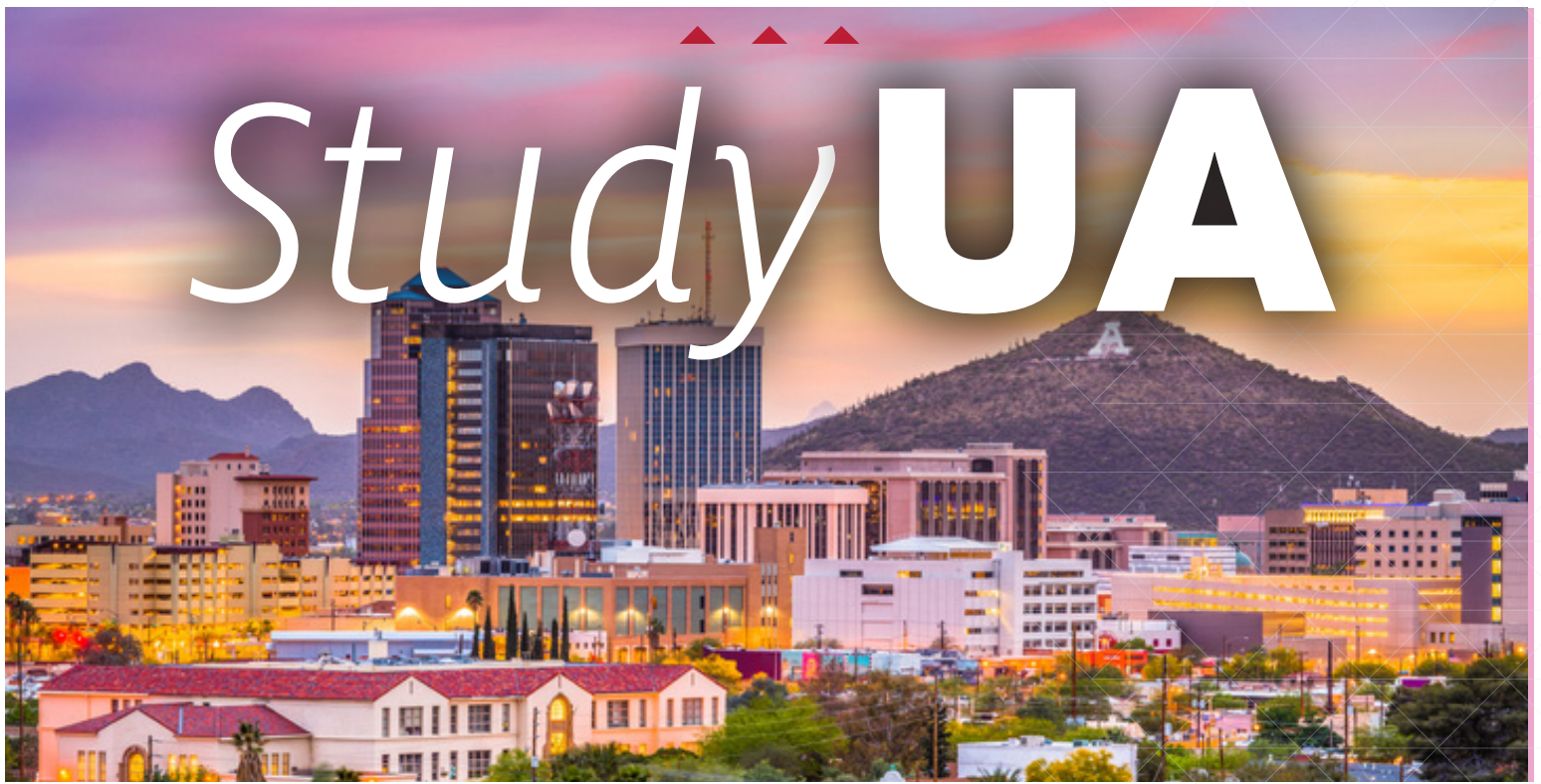


Study UA



Spend a Semester at the UA as a Visiting International Student

StudyUA offers international students from any of our partner universities the opportunity to spend a full semester studying as a non-degree student at the UA at a reduced tuition rate. Through this program students have the chance to study alongside US students at a world top-100 university in any of our academic departments, including top-ranked programs such as leadership, intercultural competence, US culture and others.

Students in this program will make lifelong friendships, improve their English proficiency and build their international professional networks. Successful students will earn a UA credit transcript.

- ▶ **Academics:** Students can take any open undergraduate credit course during either the spring or fall semester.
- ▶ **Cost:** \$9,581 USD
- ▶ **What is Included:** This fee includes up to 12 units of undergraduate credit awarded by the UA, as well as health insurance, housing, orientation, F1 student visa documentation and all student fees.

The UA also offers other opportunities for short-term non-credit study.

- ▶ **Research Mentoring Program:** This program is an intensive Research Internship at the University of Arizona where undergraduate students spend eight (8) weeks, 40 hours per week, participating in research activities, attending workshops, field trips, and a graduate school symposium.

The program offers academic, professional, and intercultural experiences for undergraduate students interested in science, technology, social sciences, and engineering to prepare students to excel as a future graduate student and as a research professional in a globally challenged world. The majority of past participants have gone on to successfully enroll in graduate programs and complete their research goals. This international experience also provides skills needed for career success.
