



[Korean for Beginner]

SHORT COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is designed for beginner learners who are starting to learn Korean from the very beginning. It is an introductory Korean language course developed to help students build their communicative competence by learning from the Korean alphabet (Hangeul) — including consonants and vowels — to practical expressions that are useful in everyday life.

READING MATERIALS

The textbook for this course is *Sungkyun Korean 1: Vocabulary and Grammar*.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS AND GRADING

All ISS classes are graded on a pass/fail basis, determined by students' academic achievement on a 100-point scale.

A total score of **60 points or higher** is required to pass the course.

According to SKKU regulations, students must attend **at least 80% of all classes** to receive a passing grade.

Active participation in class activities and completion of assignments are essential for successful course completion.

The final grade consists of the following components:

- Written Test (Final writing test): **80 points**
 - Class Participation (Active engagement during class): **10 points**
 - Assignment (Self-introduction video project): **10 points**
- Total: 100 points**
